

Brain Injury Society Responds to World Trade Tower Emergency Opens Emergency Relief Fund for Victims of Terrorists Acts on the United States of America

September 11, 2001, as people were on their way to work and at their desks, four passenger airline jets with cross county fuel tanks filled to capacity, were hijacked with the sole purpose to be used as jet-propelled terrorist weapons against residents and citizens of the United States of America. Over 6,100 people are listed missing and this number is expected to rise. Close to 300 people have been confirmed dead with this number expected to rise.

In response, Brain Injury Society has opened the Emergency Relief Fund to assist in the recovery, relief, trauma counseling, and rehabilitation of the victims of this tragedy and their families.

All proceeds of the Emergency Relief Fund will go directly to assist individuals, families and others who have been affected by this devastating terror and tragedy.
